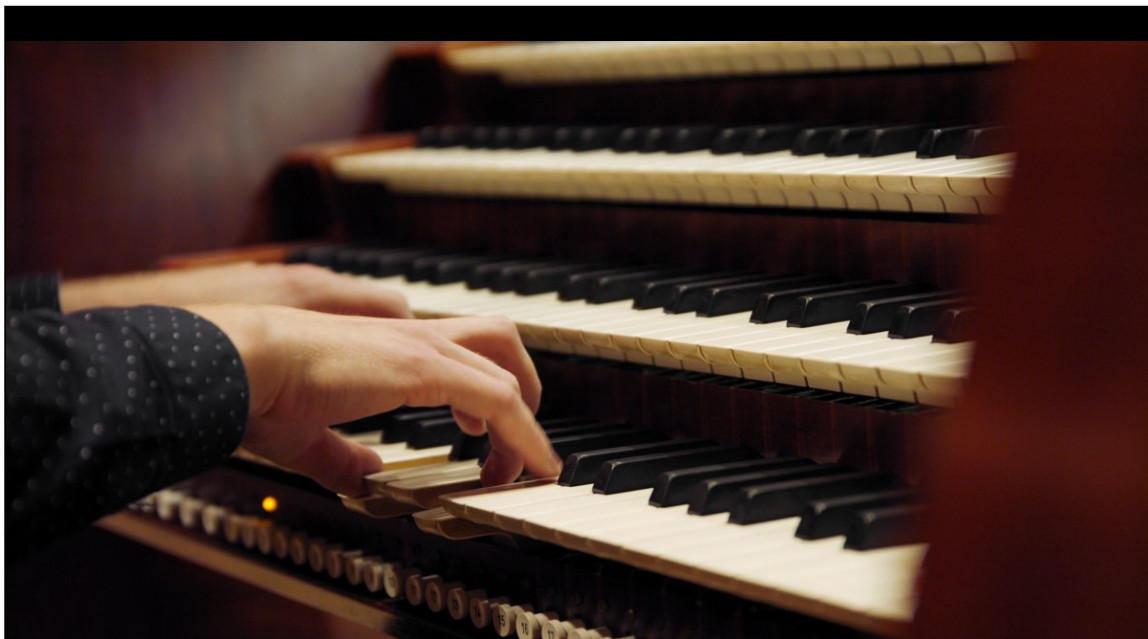

Biography: **Dave Powers**

For over 44 years, two-time EMMY® Award winning composer and performer Dave Powers has been a vital part of the Columbus, Ohio and Punta Gorda, Florida music scene as a pianist, keyboardist, vocalist, entertainer and educator. Dave has traveled and performed nationally and internationally. Dave was a consultant and a frequent guest of the Public Television Show “The Piano Guy” and has taught a series of master classes with “Piano Guy” host Scott Houston. Dave is an associated faculty member of The Ohio State University School of Music. Considered one of the most successful musicians in the Midwest, Dave manages to win over the hearts of all who hear him perform. From concerts to clubs and restaurants to corporate events and private parties, his vast repertoire is as diverse as the audience that he entertains. Dave has performed with noted performers such as Steve Allen, George Benson, Rusty Bryant, Richie Cole, Buddy DeFranco, Mark Farner (of Grand Funk Railroad), Eric Gale, Terry Gibbs, Ernie Krivda, Wilbert Longmire, Johnny Lytle, ‘Blue’ Lou Marini (of the Blues Brothers), Joan Rivers, Arturo Sandoval, Byron Stripling, Gene Walker, Grover Washington, Jr. and many others. In addition, Dave is associated with the Jazz Arts Group of Columbus, and performs with the Columbus Jazz Orchestra. For ten years, Dave hosted a jazz concert series at the Clintonville Woman’s Club called “The House Jazz Concert Series.” Recently, Dave has performed online concerts on YouTube and Facebook called “Facebook Live at Five.” Dave’s performance schedule and CD’s are available online at www.davepowers.com, Apple Music, iTunes, CD Baby.com and amazon.com (keyword: Dave Powers).



Biography: **Ken Karsh**

Ken Karsh began playing guitar at age 9 and has been deeply involved in music and music education ever since. He attended Berklee College of Music and earned his Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees in performance from Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, Pa.

Over the past several years, Ken has performed live and on recordings with nationally and locally known musicians such as Jimmy McGriff, Barry Miles, Spider Rondinelli, Eric Kloss, Bobby McFerrin, Lee Konitz, Larry Elgart, Joe Negri, Joey DeFrancesco, “Papa John” DeFrancesco, Jack McDuff, Gene



Ludwig, Bernadette Peters, Nathan Davis, Michael Gibbs and Angel Romero. One of Ken's proudest moments is his participation as guitarist for the soundtrack for the documentary film *In My Hands*, which was directed by Ann Reinking with music composed by Jeffrey Saver.

As guitarist for a variety of Pittsburgh Civic Light Opera musical theater productions, Ken has performed in such well know productions as *Legally Blonde*, *Swing*, *Les Misérables*, *Jesus Christ Superstar*, *Chess*, *Chicago*, *A Chorus Line*, *Parade* (composed by Jason Robert Brown, who conducted), *Fiddler on the Roof* (performing on guitar and mandolin), *In the Heights*, *Mamma Mia*, *Copacabana* (composed by Barry Manilow), and *The Lion King* with the Gazelle Company at the Benedum Theatre in Pittsburgh, Pa. Ken has performed with such distinguished groups as the Wheeling Symphony Orchestra, the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra, and the Pittsburgh Opera Orchestra (performing on mandolin). In 1981, he was featured as the solo electric guitarist in the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra's performance of Andre Previn's Concerto for Guitar and Orchestra. Recently, Ken performed as a member of the orchestra for the TJL production of *DooWop Generations*, currently being aired on PBS.

Ken's arrangements and etudes are featured in the Mel Bay and Warner Bros. publications *Jazz Guitar Standards (2002)*, *Jazz Guitar Standards: Chord Melody Solos* and Mel Bay's *Guitar Journals: Jazz*. He has authored two textbooks for guitar: *Jazz Scale Workout* (Mel Bay Publications) and the self-

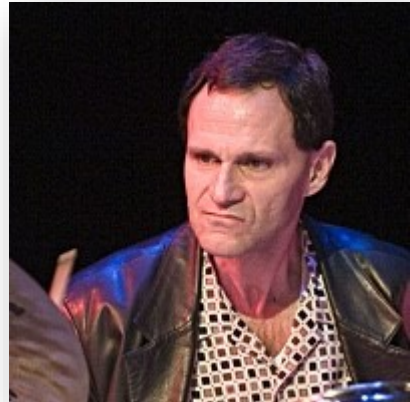
Biography: **Louis Tsamous**

Louis Tsamous grew up in Cambridge, OH and began playing the drums at age 10. He has since become one of the most versatile and active musicians in America. He has toured Europe, Asia and the Caribbean and has recorded and performed with jazz artists Stanley Turrentine, Etta Jones, Jimmy McGriff, Dr. Lonnie Smith, David "Fathead" Newman, Joey DeFrancesco and Kevin Mahogany among others.

He played in the Ohio State University Jazz Ensemble while a student at OSU and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1982.

In addition to performing with various groups in the Midwest, Louis has done clinics at many high schools and universities across the country. Louis has been touring and recording with jazz organ sensation Tony Monaco since 1999 and is featured on six national releases on The Summit record label.

Louis has recently toured the United States and Europe with jazz guitar legend Pat Martino.

Sheila del Bosque is a multi-award winning flutist, composer, educator and conductor, originally from Cuba. Her talents have brought her to major theaters and festivals in Cuba, as well as high-profile venues in SouthKorea, Mexico, Germany, and the United States. She has performed for such influential personalities as Pope Francis, Jill Biden, Usher, Bon Jovi, and The Rolling Stones.

The duo will perform original arrangements of tango, Brazilian and Cuban music.

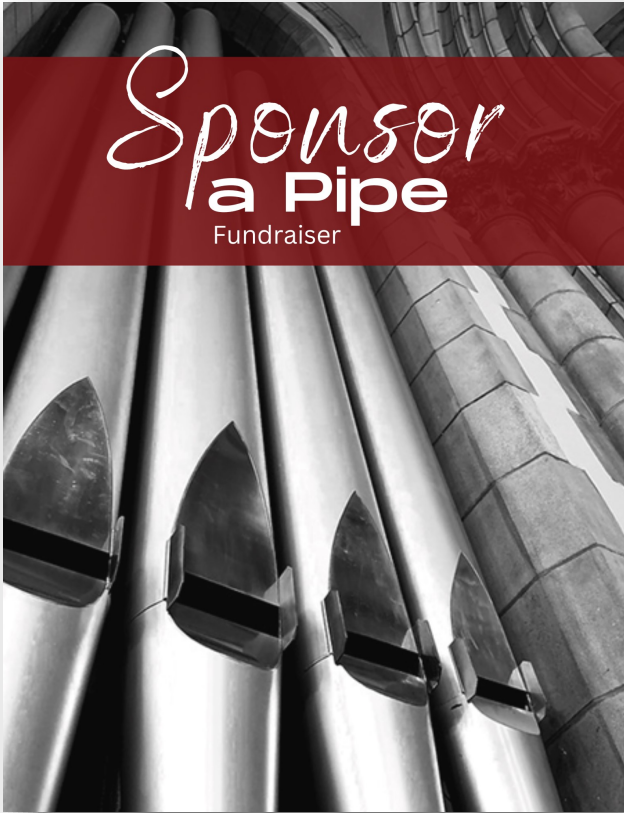

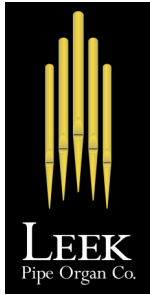
